We are blessed to have wonderful HOPE of the Grand Valley friends, and as God would have it, I received a call shortly after I posted this update on FaceBook from one of our friends that have a son with PKU. She will be mentoring Krisztina as soon as she returns.

Krisztina was to interview with Colorado Mesa University today, but she had to cancel this because of the emergency trip to Denver.

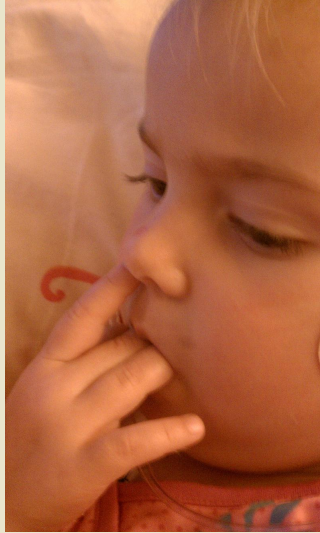
When Krisztina and Hope return, we will be actively searching for what God has for her. I know she has GREAT plans for her and for baby Hope.
